Big Sky Montana, March 24-31, 2012



Our Western Ski Trip for 2012 will be to Big Sky Resort, near Bozeman, MT. All who have been there say it's a great place to go skiing. Nancy Scherer will be our Trip Captain.

Here are some of the basics:

- March 24-31, 2012
- 3 Bedroom Condos
- Transportation bus from airport to condos
- Welcome reception
- 5 day lift-ticket w/no lift-ticket option
- Mid week après ski party
- Mountain picnic
- OVSC racing available
- Souvenir t-shirts & pins
- Awards dinner

I have been working with Skigroup.net on our Big Sky ski trip. We have made quite a bit of progress. We will be flying Delta Airlines from St. Louis on March 24 and returning to St. Louis on March 31. Because of the great deal on the air fare, the price is a mere \$1298. Also, we have excellent airline connections from St. Louis that do not require a stay over in St. Louis on either end.

There are presently 16 people going in our group. We have only 2 available spots left. We need one girl and one guy.

Please note the following ski pass options. The trip price of \$1298 includes a 5 day ski pass. If you are wanting something other than that, please let me know.

- 4 out of 5 day ticket: adult: deduct \$37 from base trip price
- 5 out of 6 day ticket: adult: Base trip price
- 6 out of 7 day ticket: adult: Add \$36 to base trip price

Following is the payment schedule for the remainder of the trip cost. If you alter your ski pass, just include or deduct accordingly on the last payment.

Each skier has already turned in \$500.

- October 10 - \$266
- November 14 - \$266
- December 12 - \$266



Make your checks payable to Tri-State Ski Club. There will be a ski club meeting each month the day before the due date, so you can bring your check to the meeting, if you like. Alternatively, you can mail the check to me at 7623 Ridgeway Ave, Evansville, IN 47715.

Also, I'd like to mention a few of the other activities that are available in case you are looking for something fun to do on the day you do not ski. There are sleigh rides, snowshoe tours, a zipline and snowmobile rides. If there is enough snow still remaining, there are snowmobile rides to Yellowstone Park. One other thing. We typically have a pizza night that is provided by the club in one of the condos. Patty Cron has suggested that we all pitch in and have a spaghetti dinner one evening together as well. I think that is a great idea. I'm open to all and any suggestions as far as evening meals go.
